RSHE - Relationships, Sex Education and Health Education

In September 2020, it became compulsory for all primary schools to teach Relationships Education (the policy can be found on our website). Within both of our schools, we are continuing to do this as part of our PSHE curriculum, following the 'Jigsaw' scheme of work. This is in line with the DfE Statutory Guidance and the Equalities Act of 2010.

Within the scheme, each term has a themed jigsaw piece:

- Term 1 - Being Me
- Term 2 - Celebrating Difference
- Term 3 - Dreams and Goals
- Term 4 - Healthy Me
- Term 5 - Relationships
- Term 6 - Changing Me

Each of the themes are age-appropriate and progressive, building over the year, with the subject of Relationships being threaded throughout the whole programme, not just considered in Term 5.

As we are currently unable to hold a full parental consultation meeting, we are sending out two leaflets, which will hopefully answer any queries you may have:

- RSHE - A guide for parents and carers
- LGBT - Parent Leaflet
