
Children in Need

Flu immunisation consent

Don't forget to consent to your child's flu nasal spray immunisation by

Monday 22nd November which will take place in school on 2nd December. (There is also the option to opt-out).

We also greatly appreciate families who are regularly using lateral flow tests for Covid-19 as a precaution.

Lateness and Unauthorised Absence

Please be aware that children arriving after 9.05am will be marked as late in the register.

Please also note that a Penalty Notice could be issued by Bath and North East Somerset Council for unauthorised absence. All unauthorised leave of absence of 5+ days will automatically incur a penalty notice. A Penalty Notice fine is £60 per child, per parent. If the fine is not paid within 21 days the amount increases to £120 per child, per parent. If your child/ren have 20 unauthorised sessions (each half day counts as one session), this will also occur a penalty notice.
